



Château Le Thil 2020

Pessac-Léognan

Le Thil is 11 hectares of vines (10 hectares Merlot, 1 hectare Cabernet Franc) planted on clay-limestone soil.

Yield: 30hl/ha

Blend:

95% Merlot

5 % Cabernet Franc

Winemaking: Grapes are sorted twice, before and after destemming, and are not pressed before undergoing fermentation in vats. Tannins and color are extracted by soft punching down and a few pumping overs.

Ageing: 14 months in barrels (30% new barrels) produced in our in-house cooperage.

Average age of the vines: 15 years old

Massal selection: with vine rootstock from the estate

Stealth Cellar: a positive energy wine facility including a Co2 recycling system into baking soda

 Château Le Thil is in it's second year of the Organic Agriculture certification
